Explanations:

1. NRS refers to the National Reporting System. Students meeting the criteria of NRS eligibility should have received services of 12 or more hours and be pre-tested using the TABE, BEST Plus or BEST Literacy tests.
2. MSG refers to Measurable Skills Gain as defined by completion of an Educational Functioning Level or the receipt of a Secondary School Diploma/Credential Attainment.
3. 'Enrollment by Funding Source' refers to a duplicated count.
4. For EPE enrollment, only NRS-eligible students will be counted. Please see note #1 for more details.
5. Please note that enrollment numbers are included as information only but may be used for evaluation purposes in future years.
6. HSE-related statistics are derived by a quarterly data match between ASISTS and the HSE database managed by NYSED. HSE diploma refers to High School Equivalency diplomas. State statistics are only for NYSED funded prep programs.
7. Students included in follow-up outcome calculations attended and exited programs in earlier years.
8. POP refers to the Period of Participation. The same student may have multiple POPs if she or he left the program and returned.
