



## Program Guide Updates

March 24th, 2024

Please be advised that the CRS 2024 reporting forms are being updated based on the feedback we have been receiving from vendors and district offices. We are anticipating that this process might continue for a couple of weeks longer. If you have completed a report on the form that was later updated, you may submit the original report. However, all new reports should be completed with the forms currently posted on the web. We strongly recommend that you always access CRS 2024 reporting forms from the web.

Definition of Students with Disabilities was changed.

963X, 1001x, and 958X: the deliverable report must be accompanied by payroll verification for the period being billed.

Page 57

MPSE - monthly reports may stop once 578X and 582X start at stabilization until case closure. Extended service reports take over the update mechanism.

Page 63 and 64

165X and 167X: Maximum of 20 hours per authorization.

Page 65

133X and 134X: Maximum of 10 hours per authorization.

Page 67

880X and 881X: Maximum of 20 hours per authorization
