## **Guidance Document for Secondary Education Institutions\***

**Purpose:** The purpose of this guidance document is to provide Secondary Education staff with a resource for providing **most recent** *existing documentation* to vocational rehabilitation (VR) staff to assist in the VR eligibility determination and vocational planning for students with disabilities. Schools must have written permission from the parent, or consent of a student 18 years of age or older, to release any information from a student's education record.

## Some examples of *existing documentation* include, yet not limited to:

\*The Office of Special Education and Rehabilitative Services requires ACCES-VR to utilize existing documentation for eligibility determination. VR Counselors also use existing documentation for vocational planning.
