- After attendance and instructions have been completed on the first day of the SRC quarterly meeting, the public comment period will be open.
  - The SRC Chair will ask if there are individuals who would like to make a public comment.
  - Comments will be provided in the order of the individuals recognized by the SRC Chair.
  - Public comments will be limited to two minutes per attendee. All public comments must meet appropriate norms of public discourse, and refrain from use of expletives or inflammatory rhetoric. Commenters will be held to this standard at the discretion of the SRC Chair.
